

What went wrong?

240 minutes = 4 hours.

The person answering the question has looked at the numbers and got confused. They have not looked at the total carefully and mistaken the '4' for four minutes in their answer.

Order the times

Remember we can convert all the times in seconds or minutes and seconds, so that we can compare them.

Minutes	Seconds
1	60
2	120
3	180
4	240
5	300
6	360
7	420
8	480
9	540
10	600
11	660
12	720

The numbers below show the correct order.

- 1 84 seconds = 1 minute and 24 seconds
- 2 2 minutes 24 seconds = 144 seconds
- 3 560 seconds = 9 minutes and 20 seconds
- 4 10 minutes 2 seconds = 602 seconds
- 6 12 minutes 87 seconds = 807 seconds
- 5 643 seconds = 10 minutes 43 seconds
