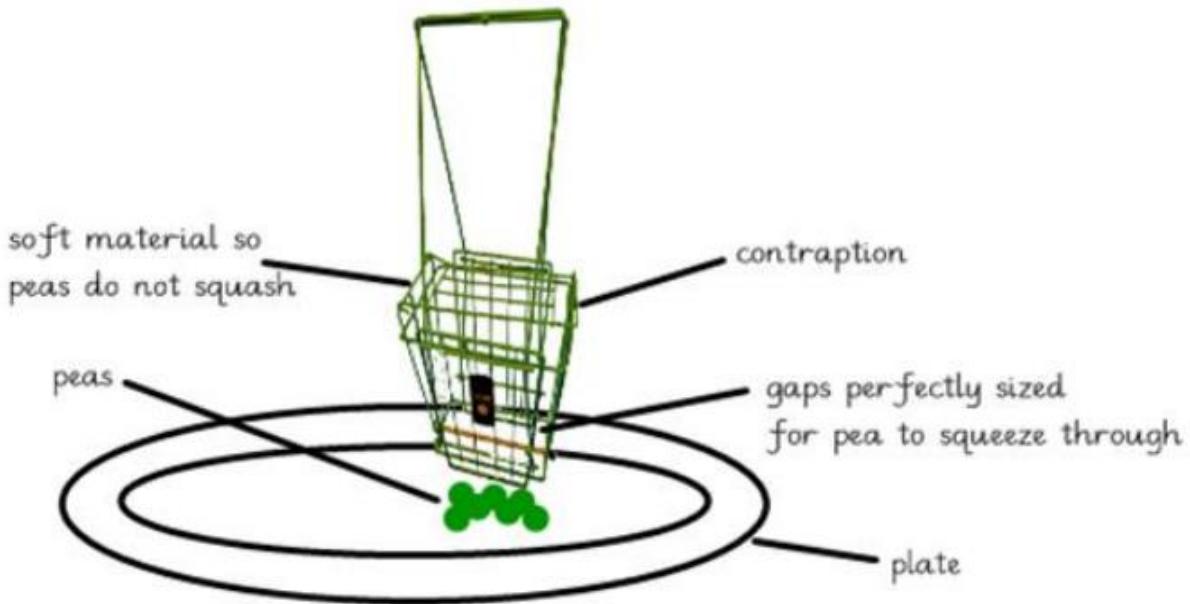
Remember to include:
