FIVE IN A ROW

WHAT YOU NEED

Board & pens/paper & pencil

HOW TO PLAY

1. The players draw a 10 by 10 grid on their board or paper.
2. The players decide who is going to be 'O's and who is going to be 'X's.
3. Each player takes it in turns to put their symbol into one of the boxes in the grid.
4. The aim of the game is to get five of the same symbols in a row.
5. The first player to do this is the winner.
