Where and what do the staff and children of our school like to read?



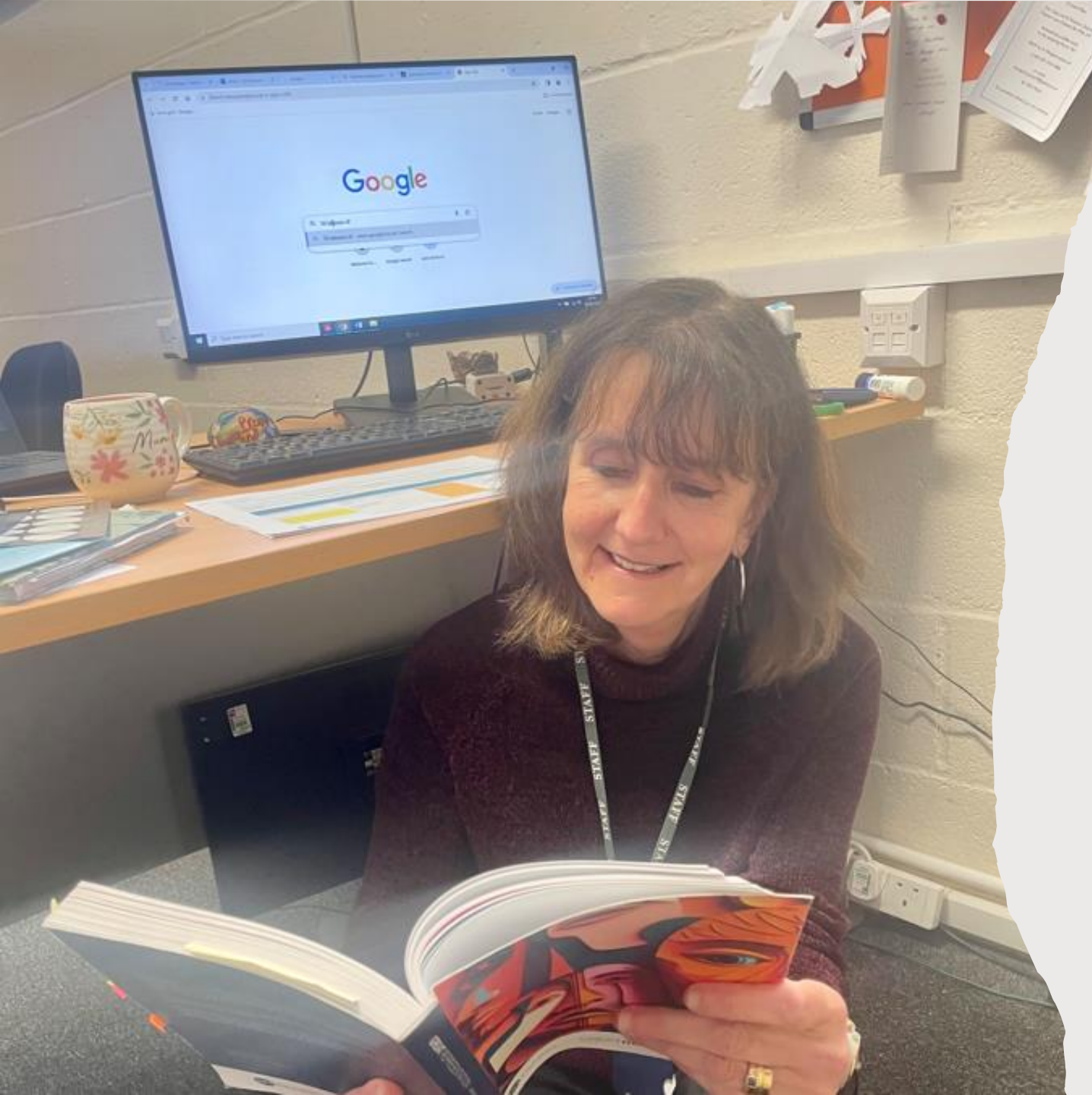
Mrs Mc Donald likes

Mrs Moccia likes to read to her granddaughter.



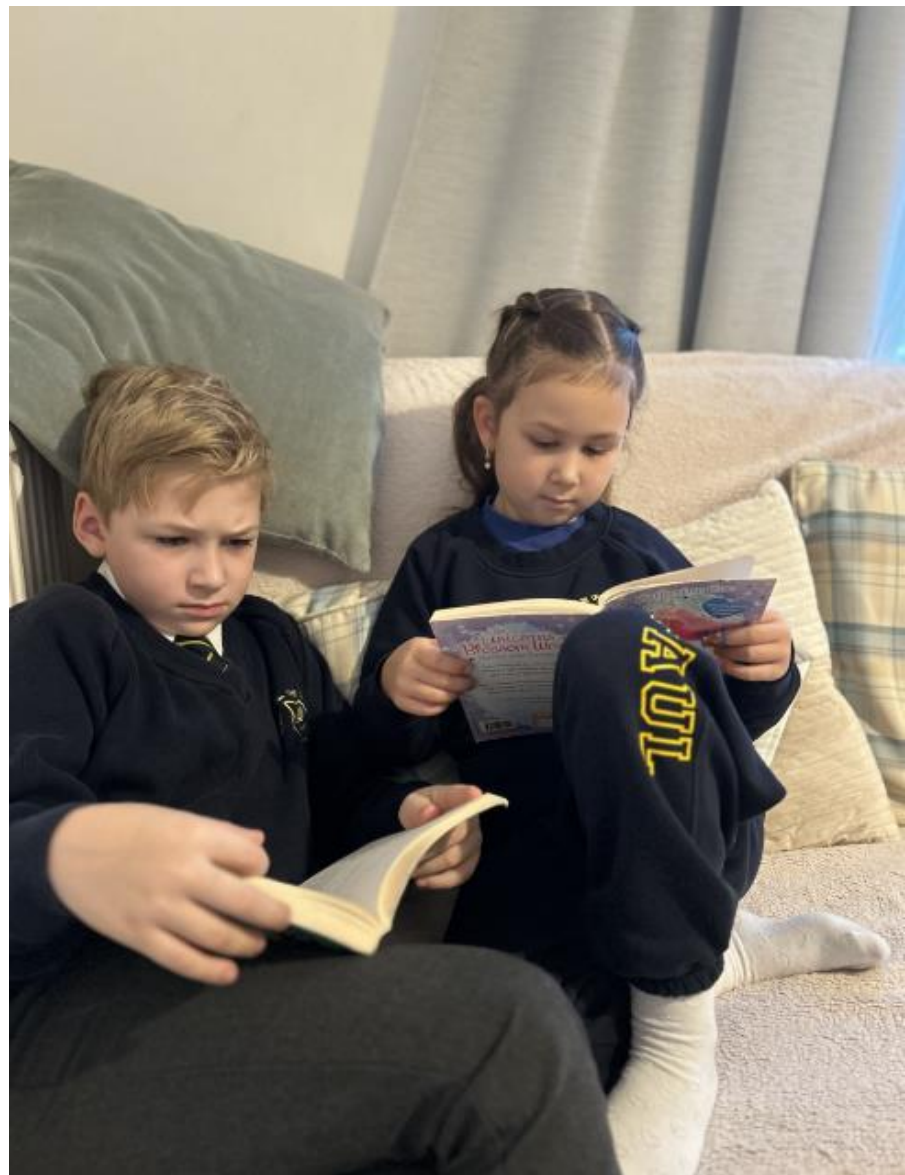

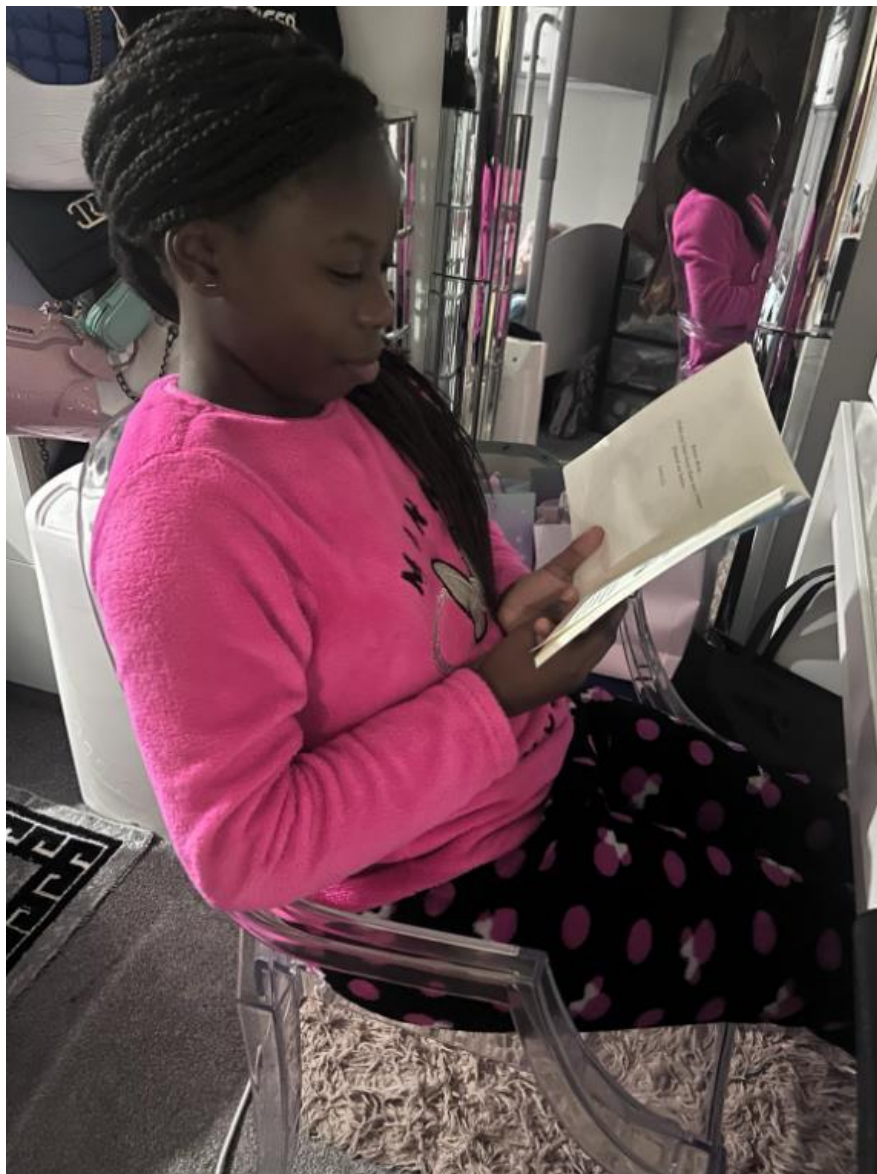
